Guidelines for Vessel Owners

If you need assistance in completing this form, please call the Marine Division at (916) 875-0740.

Note: If, after a written request from the Assessor, the property owner fails to furnish information (fails to complete and return this statement), the Assessor, based upon information in his possession, shall estimate the value of the property (Revenue and Taxation, § 501).

General Information:

The purpose of the Vessel Owner's Report is to provide the Assessor with as much information as possible to aid in determining a fair market value.

1. Every person owning personal property shall upon the request of the Assessor file a signed property statement. (Revenue and Taxation Code, § 441).
2. Vessels shall be assessed where habitually moored when not in service. (Revenue and Taxation Code, § 1139). Ownership on lien date (12:01 a.m. January 1st) determines the obligation to pay taxes. (Revenue and Taxation Code, § 2192).
3. If, after a written request from the Assessor, the property owner fails to furnish information, the Assessor, based upon information in his possession, shall estimate the value of the property. (Revenue and Taxation Code, § 501).
4. Be sure to enter the date the vessel entered Sacramento County under your ownership.

What To Do If and When:

1. **The Vessel Is Abandoned Or Destroyed**: Notify the Department of Motor Vehicles within 15 days of the occurrence and surrender to DMV the Certificate of Ownership and Certificate of Number. (California Vehicle Code, § 9864).
2. **The Vessel Is Involved In An Accident**: Report any boating accident involving death, injury, or property damage of \$100 or more to the: Department of Boating and Waterways, 1629 S Street, Sacramento CA 95814-7291.
3. **The Vessel Owner's Address Changes**: Notify DMV within 15 days if the address appearing on the Certificate of Number is no longer correct and furnish DMV with the new address. (California Vehicle Code, § 9865). Please contact the Sacramento County Assessor, Marine/Aircraft Division, at (916) 875-0740.
4. **The Vessel Ownership Is Transferred**: The former owner is required to provide DMV a written Notice of the transfer within 5 days. (California Vehicle Code, § 9911). The new owner is required to apply for a transfer of ownership with DMV within 10 days by presenting to DMV the Certificate of Ownership and Certificate of Number. (California Vehicle Code, § 9901). Please contact the Sacramento County Assessor, Marine/Aircraft Division, at (916) 875-0740.
5. **The Vessel Is Moved**: When the vessel is permanently moved, please provide the Marine and Aircraft Division, Sacramento County Assessor, (916) 875-0740 with the CF number, owner's name and new location of the vessel.
6. **There Is A Vessel Status Change**: If on January 1st the vessel is in a damaged condition or has been sold or permanently relocated, please submit information in writing to: Sacramento County Assessor, Marine/Aircraft Unit, 3636 American River Drive, Suite 200, Sacramento CA 95864-5952.
